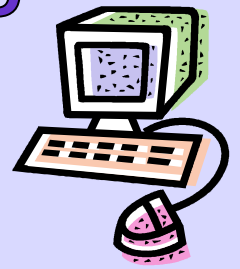

 - **Parent information and family learning.**
 - **Easy access to specialist services.**
- **Opportunities for the community to use local facilities and take part in adult learning.**

Varied Menu of activities

Varied menu of activities gives children and young people opportunities to excel outside the classroom, transforming attitudes and building self esteem.

Parent Support
